

DMTD SEBRING EVENT INFORMATION JAN 30-31, 2024 SCENATIONAL RA

PLEASE SHARE THIS INFORMATION WITH ALL DRIVERS, CREW **MEMBERS, TRUCK DRIVERS AND TEAM MANAGERS**

LOAD IN: Monday, January 29 at 5:30pm (or earlier, if the paddock is open). If you arrive at SIR before our load in, proceed through GATE 4 (Carroll Shelby Road) for staging on the skid pad. Track waivers can be signed, and track wristbands issued, starting Monday at approximately 8am at Gate 4.

- **PARKING:** Map for parking options for Sebring below.
 - BLUE spaces are reserved for DMTD/PCA sponsors that have reserved parking through PCA.
 - o GRAY spaces can be used if you're staying through PCA, but do not have PCA parking assignment. DMTD only - park in gray.
- If you're arriving at the track on Monday, January 29, you may drop off and set up until 9:00pm. PCA volunteers will be on hand to help direct you to your (if reserved) assigned parking spot. ONLY registered participants will be allowed access to the paddock on Monday evening. Transport drivers must have the name(s) of the DMTD registered participants in their haulers to access the paddock. Please make sure that you provide your transport drivers with this information.
- PADDOCK ACCESS: will be restricted for transporters, towed vehicles and motorhomes after 9:00pm on Monday and anytime the track is hot. Access for these restricted vehicles will be as follows:

Monday, 1/29: Load in until 9:00pm

Tuesday, 1/30: 6:00am to 7:45am, 12:00pm to 12:45pm, 4:00pm to 8:00pm

Wednesday, 1/31: 6:00am to 7:45am, 12:00pm to 12:45pm

- **REGISTRATION:** will take place in the Gallery of Legends building on Tuesday morning from 6:15am and will close promptly at 7:30am. You will be required to sign our Release and Waiver of Liability and Indemnity agreement and will then be issued a windshield sticker and a wristband for both days of the event. If you have a co-driver or are working with a coach, please remember that we must have a registration account on file for your co-driver/coach.
- **DRIVER MEETING:** There will be a **MANDATORY DRIVER MEETING ON TUESDAY** MORNING AT 7:30AM in the Gallery of Legends building. If you're working with a coach, your coach is required to attend this meeting with you.

HOURS: The track will be hot each day as follows:

8:00am-12:00pm: Regular/Standard Format

12:00pm-1:00pm: Advanced/Unrestricted passing only 1:00pm-4:00pm: Regular/Standard Format

4:00pm-6:00pm: Advanced/Unrestricted passing only

- **NUMBERS:** will be of contrasting color and no less than 10" high on each side of the vehicle and no less than 6" high on a vertical surface at the rear of the vehicle. You will not be allowed access to the race track without a conforming set of numbers.
- **CONCESSIONS**: The Track Shack, at the base of the tower, will be open for breakfast and lunch for both days of the event from 7:00am until 2:00pm.
- <u>TIRE SERVICE</u>: Mounting and balancing services will be available from FRISBY TIRE. If you
 want to pre-order tires for delivery to the track, please contact Derek Schaefer:

- **FUEL:** will be available from the fuel island at the track. VP fuel may be ordered from our website and delivered to the track.
- TRACK DAMAGE: drivers are financially responsible for damage that they cause to, but not limited to, guard rails, barriers and posts and for any absorbent material used to clean up after fluid spills and for any fire suppression expended on their behalf.
- <u>NOTE</u>: please re-familiarize yourself with the "rules and regulations" section of our website (<u>www.davidmurry.com</u>), paying particular attention to our **passing protocols**.
- <u>PCA drivers registration</u>: PCA registration will be open in Gallery of Legends Building on Wednesday 9am-1pm.
- <u>Tents and canopies</u>: Anyone needing to rent a tent or canopy please contact Sebring Raceway EARLY to order.

Parking: PCA Follows us



Options for Parking, DMTD- Jan 30-31, 2024:

- *If you are not staying for PCA event; park anywhere in the GRAY parking area. You must be out of paddock by Wednesday @ 5:30PM. Advance unrestricted group by 7:00PM. (You can stay later if you park in the Grid area).
- •If you are staying through PCA event, don't have a blue reserved spot with PCA, and don't want to move after DMTD; Park anywhere in the GRAY parking area. Do NOT park in Grid area.
- •If you are staying through PCA event, get with Jim Farmer with PCA and get a designated parking space.
